International Exhibition

Call for submissions October 2015

The International Exhibition, a traditional part of the Brno Biennial, will present a selection of submitted works created over the past four years.

The International Exhibition will be focused on graphic design projects in a scope corresponding to small sets – editions, visual identities or long term collaborations – in other words examples of a consistent approach spanning a range of applications, media and techniques. The intention is to present a coherent selection of projects represented in their entirety and by doing so to enable deeper insight into the profession of graphic design. One-off projects and solitary works will not be included in the International Exhibition.

A group of designers and design theorists will assess each submitted work on the basis of its originality of approach, aesthetic and functional qualities, and with a special regard given to the project as a whole, while bearing in mind the spatial limitations of the exhibition space.

The international jury comprising of leading figures in graphic design will award a number of prizes, including the Grand Prix of the 27th International Biennial of Graphic Design Brno – The Minister of Culture of the Czech Republic Award, The Mayor of the City of Brno Award and Czech Centres Award given to a Czech graphic designer under the age of 35.

The International Exhibition is open to work created between 1 January 2012 and 31 December 2015. The projects can be <u>submitted electronically</u> starting October 2015. The authors of selected works will mail the artefacts for the exhibition by post.

The application is free of charge.
