Meet the Brno Biennial 29/9 – 2/10/2016

New Boost to the International Biennial of Graphic Design at the turn of September and October.

The so-called *Meet the Brno Biennial* event will take place from Thursday 29 September to Sunday 2 October in the buildings of the Moravian Gallery and elsewhere as well; it is a four-day series of commented visits, workshops and other accompanying events. Adults as well as children will enjoy themselves.

Brno will witness four days of intense programme dedicated to graphic design. Meet the Brno Biennial will include a number of commented visits, a Pecha Kucha Night, an art workshop for children, a book launch and a film festival. Visitors will get a unique chance to learn interesting information on individual exhibitions and to discuss details of their realization directly with the curators. The special week-end will start in advance already on Thursday evening, when a Pecha Kucha Night dedicated to graphic design will take place in café Praha. Anyway, the essential part of the event will consist of commented exhibition visits; the International Exhibition will be commented by Oliver Klimpel, a graphic designer now living in Berlin and a member of the Brno Biennial Selection Jury. Another international encounter, taking place on Saturday 1st October in the evening in the Museum of Applied Arts, will feature Nina Paim, Emilia Bergmark and Corinne Gisel, the curators of an exhibition from the Brno Biennial past edition. Their exhibition was titled Taking a Line for a Walk and it was dealing with assignments in design education; this time we will have the pleasure to launch their book with the same title. On Sunday, the event will move from the gallery to the cinema, or, more precisely, to Art Cinema, where a one-day festival will present films provided by posters by the legendary Czech graphic designer Zdeněk Ziegler. Children can look forward to the Saturday art studio inspired by Ziegler's posters and to the film The Stolen Airship directed by Karel Zeman, adults to the screening of The Birds by Hitchcock that will conclude the whole programme of Meet the Brno Biennial.

The authors of the 27th year of the Brno Biennial are, as in the last edition, the graphic designers Radim Peško, Tomáš Celizna and Adam Macháček.
